



STEPS TO OBTAIN NEW TITLE FOR MANUFACTURED AND MOBILE HOMES

The following steps must be completed in the Franklin County Courthouse, located at 373 South High Street, before proceeding to the Auto Title Offices, or after receiving court order.

19 th Floor Auditor's Office	 Present Title to The Franklin County Auditor's Office, Transfer and Conveyance Section: Between the hours of 8:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. A Transfer and Conveyance Fee will need to be paid, unless the transfer is exempt. Title will be copied and a check of the current tax status. Complete Transfer and Conveyance Forms DTE 100 or DTE 101, and other applicable forms. Receive Conveyance and Transfer stamps on Title. Pay Transfer Fee of \$.50 Pay Conveyance Fee, which is currently \$2.00 per Thousand dollars and .20 cents per hundred on the purchase price. Effective 1/12/06 <i>Example</i>: \$20,500.00 would be \$41.00 Conveyance Fee. Present the Title to the Treasurer's Office:
17 th Floor	Receive a Red Validation Stamp if all taxes are paid in full.
Treasurer's Office	 If not paid the Treasurer will create a bill, which must be paid in full to
Treasurer's Office	receive the Red Validation Stamp

Tax Due Dates	Taxes are due on <u>March 1st</u> of each year. You can choose to pay the entire amount due on March 1 st , or half on March 1 st and July 31 st of each year.
