Welcome to Ohio!



Are you a new resident of Ohio? If you recently relocated to Ohio and need to convert your vehicle title to an Ohio title, let us be your county of choice!

Why do I need an Ohio title?

To register your vehicle in Ohio and obtain Ohio license plates, your out-of-state title must first be converted to an Ohio title.

What do I need to bring?

- 1. Physical certificate of title (photocopies of titles are <u>not</u> accepted. Joint ownership requires all owners to be present unless a notarized power of attorney is provided. Social security numbers for all owners are required).
- 2. A valid government-issued driver's license or identification card
- 3. An Ohio BMV Out-of-State Inspection form. *Inspections may be obtained at Auto Title South only, any Ohio BMV deputy registrar, or new car dealership in Ohio. Inspection fees may apply.*
- 4. Ohio <u>Application for Certificate of Title</u> and <u>Applicant's Affidavit Odometer Statement</u> *Note: These forms can be obtained and completed in our office.*
- 5. Bill of sale from original purchase of vehicle In many instances, a bill of sale is needed from your original purchase of the vehicle to determine any tax liability.
- 6. Lien release from your lienholder or letter of permission from lienholder, if applicable
 -A lien release letter is required if a lien indicated on your out-of-state title <u>has been satisfied</u>.
 -A letter of permission is required if there is an active lien on your title and your name has changed, or you wish to add or remove an owner.
- 7. <u>Lease transactions only</u>. Power of attorney from leasing company (lessor). Your leasing company's Ohio leasing dealer permit (LD#) or vendor number (99#) and the company's federal tax ID (EIN) will also be required.
- 8. \$16.50 title fee (additional fees may apply). We accept cash, check or credit card (with a 3% convenience fee). Please make checks payable to: Franklin County Clerk of Courts.

What if my lienholder or leasing company is holding the title?

Complete a <u>Title Request</u> form and mail/fax/email it to your lienholder or leasing company. The Title Request form and instructions are available at our office or at: <u>forms.franklincountyautotitle.com</u>.
